Bach Solo Cello Suites

Guy Fishman, Artist in Residence

Cellist Guy Fishman is Arlington Street's newest addition to our thriving Artist in Residence program! Beginning back in the fall of 2008 and continuing through this spring, Guy's residency features performances of all six of Johann Sebastian Bach's solo cello suites; today's visit marks the fifth installment. The suites were most likely composed between 1717 and 1723; nearly 300 years later, they continue to be regarded as some of the greatest works ever written for the instrument.
